History

The Victorians

To learn about how the Victorians changed our world today! We will study the use of workhouses, the education system, the differences between rich and poor people as well as how the Industrial Revolution and Charles Darwin influenced our understanding of the world.

Science

Living Things & Their Habitats

Understanding how we classify animals and plants using classification and dichotomous keys using shared characteristics.

Understanding how living things have evolved over millions of years—including the role natural selection and adaptation allows for survival of the fittest!

Use inspiration from Victorian embroidery to create a coaster using different stitch techniques.
