

CURRICULUM FRENCH



Intent:

We aim for our pupils to enjoy learning French, build confidence in using new words and phrases, and understand the importance of learning another language. We want our pupils to have fun, learn some simple French conversation and be curious about French culture (Bastille day).

Implementation

French is taught regularly in KS2 using engaging resources, provide engaging resources. We use Rising Stars to facilitate the planning and delivery of French in a suitably sequenced way.

Classes in KS 2 are encouraged to have a French display, and pupils are encouraged to record some of their learning in their French notebooks. Overall, speaking and listening takes preference over written recording for this subject.

We also use daily incidental French throughout the school when appropriate.

Impact

KS2 pupils develop stronger French skills, enjoy learning the language, and feel more confident speaking and writing in French.

Pupils' progress will be visible through improved use of French vocabulary and the ability to hold simple conversations, improved work in books, positive pupil voice, and greater engagement in French learning.
